RE: Cardiac Arrest Online Medical Control (OLMC) Education

As we continue to improve the out of hospital cardiac arrest care and survival in the Chicago EMS System, we recognize that the base station consultation between EMS providers and ECRNs/ECPs is a critical component in this process. We have created a module to focus on the online medical control (OLMC) at the base station. This education is mandatory for all ECRNs and strongly encouraged for ECPs. There are two options, either in-person sessions with the EMS Coordinator/EMS Medical Director at your hospital or through our online learning site. We are in the process of updating our Region XI EMS website, but currently all online education will be done through the website listed below.

The training will be available on March 1st, 2017 and must be completed by June 1st, 2017.

The online module takes a minimum of 30 minutes to complete. To access the Region XI EMS System website, enter in your web browser:

- Step 1: www.RegionXlemssystem.org
- Step 2: Click on the "Continuing Education" tab
- Step 3: Select the following link and click on it: "Region XI EMS ECRN& ECP Education Site (Hospitals and Base Stations)"
- Step 4: If you have not completed education on this site, create a new account. If you have an account, sign in using your username and password you chose when you registered. If you don't remember your username or password, you may request a new password and it will be emailed to the email you used when you registered. The new password MUST be used within 30 minutes of the request.
- Step 5: At the completion of the education, print your certificate and submit it to your EMS coordinator. The course is timed, and if you do not spend the required time in the course, a certificate will NOT print
