

# INTRA-NASAL DRUG ADMINISTRATION

## Mucosal Atomization Device (MAD)

### INDICATIONS

- Opioid Overdose – Naloxone (Adults & Pediatrics)

### CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Nasal trauma

### EQUIPMENT

1. Mucosal Atomizer Device (MAD)
2. Syringe

### PROCEDURE

1. Draw up dose of medication into syringe
2. Expel air from syringe
3. Remove needle and attach MAD to syringe
4. Insert tip of MAD into nostril.
5. Rapidly administer medication (1ml max per nostril; recommend giving ½ the volume in each nostril)
6. Document the medication dose and patient response.

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
