INTRA-NASAL DRUG ADMINISTRATION Mucosal Atomization Device (MAD)

INDICATIONS

Opioid Overdose – Naloxone (Adults & Pediatrics)

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Nasal trauma

<u>EQUIPMENT</u>

- 1. Mucosal Atomizer Device (MAD)
- 2. Syringe

PROCEDURE

- 1. Draw up dose of medication into syringe
- 2. Expel air from syringe
- 3. Remove needle and attach MAD to syringe
- 4. Insert tip of MAD into nostril.
- 5. Rapidly administer medication (1ml max per nostril; recommend giving ½ the volume in each nostril)
- 6. Document the medication dose and patient response.
