Region XI EMS Monthly Pearls

- October is Sudden Cardiac Arrest awareness month! Our increasing survival outcomes in the Region XI EMS system are due to the important collaboration between bystanders, dispatchers, EMS providers, and hospital personnel.
- All cardiac arrests should be uploaded to Codestat for review and feedback regarding the EMS component of the resuscitation. Many are still not uploaded or incorrectly performed in 'Lead 2' instead of the required 'Paddles' mode.
- Illinois Poison Center (IPC) is a resource for EMS and hospital providers to consult with a specialist on ingestions and may be reached at 1-800-222-1222.
- The Chicago Marathon is Sunday, October 8th, please be aware of road closures and exercise-induced hyponatremia and hyperthermia in race participants.
