SUBJECT: REGIONAL BENZODIAZEPINE STANDARDIZATION & ADDITIONAL CHANGES TO REQUIRED

**MEDICATIONS FOR ALS COMPANIES** 

## **Regional Benzodiazepine Standardization**

Effective immediately, Diazepam (Valium) will no longer be a required medication on Region XI transport or non-transport Advanced Life Support (ALS) vehicles. The preferred benzodiazepine is now Midazolam (Versed); the required regional inventory is <u>20 mg total per vehicle</u>. The required concentration of <u>5mg/1ml (10mg/2ml)</u> will be standardized across the region.

Effective July 1, 2014: All CFD ALS vehicles MUST have a total inventory of <u>exactly 20 mg Versed</u> at the standardized concentration of 5mg/1ml (10mg/2ml). All overage of Diazepam (Valium) or Midazolam (Versed) including differing concentrations other than 5mg/1ml (10mg/2ml) shall be discarded appropriately at the <u>assigned resource hospital</u>.

## Additional Changes in Required Medications for ALS Companies

Effective immediately, the use of Lasix in the pre-hospital setting will be discontinued.

Effective immediately, the use of Dopamine in the pre-hospital setting will be discontinued.
