Region XI EMS Monthly Pearls

- For motor vehicle accidents: **INTRUSION** is the measured defect <u>into the</u>

 <u>passenger compartment</u> which is different from the EXTERNAL auto deformation
- The **Pediatric Assessment Triangle (PAT)** can be used to quickly evaluate a sick child and is based on the **A**ppearance, work of **B**reathing, **C**irculation to the skin
- Needle decompression should be performed on patients with thoracic trauma AND traumatic arrest or evidence of tension pneumothorax such as SBP< 90mmHg AND respiratory distress or respiratory failure, NOT solely for isolated decreased breath sounds</p>
- ➤ Cardiac arrests should have the monitor in *manual mode* to allow for prompt rhythm recognition and defibrillation every 2 minutes, which minimizes the time without chest compressions
- ➤ There is a **MANDATORY Region XI Policy Update module** for all EMT-B, EMT-P, ECRN, and ECPs to be completed prior to July 16th. To complete the training, EMTs should login to Target Solutions and ECRNs/ECPs should refer to your EMS Coordinator or EMS Medical Director
