Region XI EMS Monthly Pearls

- ➤ **Termination of Resuscitation** should be considered after five rounds of epinephrine as per EMS system policy, previous epinephrine shortages have resolved.
- For **Online Medical Control (OLMC)** calls, the report should begin with the unit <u>I</u>dentification, then the <u>S</u>ituation or reason for the call, <u>B</u>ackground, <u>A</u>ssessment, <u>R</u>x (treatment)/<u>R</u>esponse/<u>R</u>equest (I-SBAR).
- For **Pre-Notification** calls, this should be presented as a brief, clear report that provides pertinent information to the receiving hospital staff.
- > Trauma patients should have a **neurological exam** assessed and documented, this includes mental status, motor and sensory evaluation.
- ➤ The mandatory **Adult Assessment** assignment must be completed on Target Solutions by September 17th and users may verify successful completion of the education under the 'My History' section.
