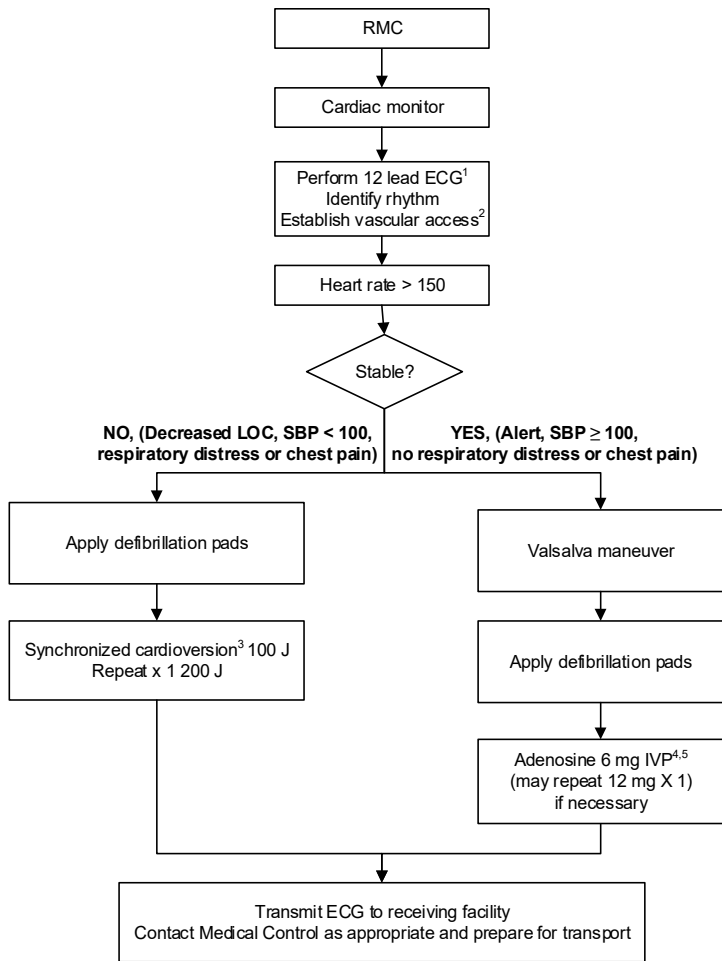

**NARROW COMPLEX TACHYCARDIA - ALS
(Pulse >150)**



1 – See 12 Lead Electrocardiogram (ECG) procedure

2 – If unconscious/unstable, defer vascular access until after cardioversion.

3 - If conscious, consider analgesia prior to cardioversion: Morphine Sulfate 0.1 mg/kg IVP **OR** Fentanyl 1 mcg/kg IVP
 ≤ 65 years of age - max dose 10 mg ≤ 65 years of age - max dose 100 mcg
 > 65 years of age - max dose 5 mg > 65 years of age - max dose 50 mcg

4 - Use antecubital if possible. Also, follow rapid IV injection with immediate 10 ml flush of NS.

5 - If history of reactive airway/asthma/COPD, contact Online Medical Control prior to use of adenosine.
