Region XI EMS Monthly Pearls

- ➤ Paramedic Competency Testing will be held for Chicago Fire Department in February/March and for Private Providers in April. <u>CFD paramedics should sign up</u> for an open date now and Private Provider dates are being scheduled.
- ➤ Opiate pain medications are now weight based dosing. Morphine is 0.1 mg/kg IV. For patients age ≤ 65 y/o the maximum dose is 10 mg and for age > 65 y/o the maximum dose is 5 mg.
- > VAD patients should be transferred to a VAD center, and preferentially their VAD center if within 25 minutes.
- ➤ Comprehensive Stroke Centers are capable to care for severe strokes as they have 24/7 advanced imaging and procedures, trained personnel and a Neurological ICU.
- For Cardiac Arrest **CARES** questions an arrest is considered 'witnessed' if it was seen or heard by anyone including EMS.
