Drug Name: Epinephrine – Pediatric Bradycardia

DRUG NAME - GENERIC	Epinephrine: Pediatric Bradycardia
DRUG NAME - TRADE	Epinephrine
DRUG CLASSIFICATION	Adrenergic agonist
DOSAGE FORMS	1:10,000 (0.1 mg/mL), Injectable, Preload
ACTION(S)	- Stimulates alpha and beta receptors increasing heart rate and blood pressure
INDICATIONS	- Pediatric: Bradycardia pulse <60 AND severe cardiorespiratory compromise
CONTRAINDICATIONS	- None
ADULT DOSE / ROUTE	N/A
PEDIATRIC DOSE / ROUTE	- 0.01 mg/kg (0.1 mL/kg of the 0.1mg/mL concentration [1:10,000]) IV/IO - Repeat q 3-5 min during bradycardia/cardiorespiratory compromise
SIDE EFFECTS	- Palpitations, tachycardia, hypertension, angina, anxiety, tremors, headache
