Drug Name: Naloxone

DRUG NAME - GENERIC	Naloxone
DRUG NAME - TRADE	Narcan
DRUG CLASSIFICATION	Opioid antagonist
DOSAGE FORMS	2 mg/2 ml, Prefilled Syringe
ACTION(S)	- Binds the opioid receptor and blocks the effects of opioids
INDICATIONS	- Reversal of acute respiratory depression from suspected opioid toxicity
CONTRAINDICATIONS	- None
ADULT DOSE / ROUTE	- ALS 1-2 mg IV/IO/IM or 2mg nebulized OR IN - BLS 2 mg IN
PEDIATRIC DOSE / ROUTE	- ALS ≤ 20 kg: 0.1 mg/kg IV/IO/IM/IN up to 2 mg. >20 kg: 2 mg IV/IO/IM/IN - BLS 0-4 years old: 1 mg IN >4 years old 2 mg IN
SIDE EFFECTS	- Withdrawal symptoms (agitation, nausea, vomiting), tachycardia, hypertension, seizures.
