## COMMON ANTICOAGULANT AND ANTIPLATELET DRUGS

I. **Anticoagulant Drugs:** Prevent blood coagulation by reducing the action of clotting factors.

| <b>Vitamin K Antagonist</b>             | Warfarin     | Coumadin   |
| <b>Direct Oral Anticoagulant (DOAC)</b> | Apixaban     | Eliquis    |

|   | Rivaroxaban  | Xarelto    |
| <b>Heparin (low molecular weight)</b>   | Enoxaparin   | Lovenox    |

| <b>Anticoagulant (other)</b>            | Fondaparinux | Arixtra    |

II. **Antiplatelet Drugs:** Prevent platelets from binding together and forming clots.
