Offered through the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT), the PHTLS Provider Course is a 16-hour program for EMTs, paramedics, nurses, physician assistants and other emergency medical providers. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive a *Certificate of Completion*, a wallet card recognizing them as a PHTLS provider for 4 years, and 16 hours of continuing education credit.

The PHTLS course improves the quality of trauma care with the goal of decreasing mortality. PHTLS promotes critical thinking as the foundation of providing quality care. The following topics are covered:

- Physiology of Life and Death
- Scene Assessment
- Patient Assessment
- Airway
- Breathing, Ventilation and Oxygenation
- Circulation, Hemorrhage and Shock
- Patient with Disabilities
- Patient Simulations
