Offered through the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT), the TECC Provider Course is a **16-hour program** for law enforcement officers, EMTs, paramedics, nurses, physician assistants and other medical providers. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive a Certificate of Completion, a wallet card recognizing them as a TECC provider for 4 years and 16 hours of continuing education credit through CAPCE.

The TECC course teaches practitioners how to respond to and care for patients in a civilian tactical environment. The following topics are covered:

- Direct threat care rendered while under attack or in adverse conditions
- Indirect threat care that is rendered while the threat has been tentatively suppressed
- Evacuation care that is rendered while the casualty is being evacuated
- Hemorrhage and airway control
- Strategies for treating wounded responders in threatening environments
- Caring for pediatric patients
- Techniques for dragging and carrying victims
