The EMT course is designed to give the student basic Emergency Medical Training. This includes all skills necessary for the individual to provide prehospital emergency medical care at a basic life support level with an ambulance service or other specialized service. Specifically, the course is designed to provide training to recognize the nature or extent of a patient's condition to administer appropriate emergency medical care to stabilize the patient's condition, lift move, position, and otherwise handle the patient to minimize discomfort and prevent further injury and transport them safely to the proper medical facility.

18 years of age

High School Diploma or GED Certificate

Completion of English 101 or Score of 6 on the reading placement exam.

Fully vaccinated for COVID -19
(this is a requirement to complete the program)
