SUBJECT: **UPDATE TO REGION 11 DRUG, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLY (DES) LIST**

The Region 11 Drug, Equipment, and Supply (DES) List provides the current and minimum required items to be carried on all BLS and ALS units that operate under the Chicago EMS System. As an update to this list, the following changes have been made to align with the upcoming "Medication Administration Update 2022". Overall, the "Alternative Medications Used During Drug Shortages" section was removed, epinephrine glass ampules have been replaced by epinephrine vials, the pink and yellow size intraosseous (IO) needles have been added with removal of the manual IO and other minor updates.

Medications

- Removed morphine as a pain management alternative during times of shortage
- Removed lorazepam and diazepam as alternatives during times of shortage
- Reinforcement of Dextrose 10% for treatment of hypoglycemia (D50 previously removed from DES)
- Removed "ampule" from Epinephrine in the Epi Kit section, replaced with "vial"
- Removed "ampule" from 1:1000 Epinephrine, replaced with "vial"

Medication Administration

- Added Needles, 23 Gauge x 1 inch
- Added Needles, 23 Gauge x 1.5 inch
- Removed "15 gauge IO needle sherwood or jam shidi"
- Revised EZ-IO Driver to indicate Private Provider Replacement as optional additional equipment
- Added "EZ-IO Needle, Pink (15mm) + Stabilizer Kit". Quantity 1, Hospital Replacement, ALS
- Revised "EZ-IO Needle, Blue" to include the addition of "(25 mm) + Stabilizer Kit".
- Added "EZ-IO Needle Yellow (45 mm) + Stabilizer Kit". Quantity 1, Hospital Replacement, ALS





ALL EXCHANGE ITEMS MUST BE IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE TO THE EMERGENCY CARE PERSONNEL SO AS NOT TO DELAY THEIR RETURN TO SERVICE.

APPROVAL OF SIMILAR TYPE EQUIPMENT MUST BE MADE BY THE EMS MEDICAL DIRECTORS CONSORTIUM

The following items must be made available to the emergency care personnel for use and exchange in the event a patient with a suspected communicable disease had been transported:

- * Cleaning detergent -- low sudding, neutral pH
- * Disinfectant solution in compliance with OSHA Standards

The number in the "No. of items" column indicates the minimum quantity of the drug, supply or exchange equipment that must be carried on each Ambulance in Region 11.

"X"s in the indicated columns convey the following meanings:

HOSPITAL: It is the responsibility of the Participating Hospital to replace the drug, supply or exchange the equipment item as indicated.

PROVIDER - Private: It is the responsibility of the Provider to replace the drug, supply or exchange the equipment item indicated.

Provider - CFD: This piece of equipment is unique to the Chicago Fire Department. The CFD is the only provider in the system required to have this drug, supply or piece of equipment in their inventory. The CFD is responsible for the replacement of this item.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE: These drugs are controlled substances.
